

ARCHERY

1. Anyone using the archery facilities must sign in on the archery sheet on the porch and put up the **YELLOW FLAG**. Take the flag down when the last shooter is finished. **No hiking on Archery Course.**
2. When entering the course you must follow trails. Start at target #1. No backtracking! No shortcuts!
3. Jumping ahead of other shooters may be done only with their permission, although slower groups should allow faster shooters to jump ahead.
4. Broadheads may be used in the Broadhead Pit **only.**
5. Archery Course is to be used by **MEMBERS ONLY**.
6. Junior members may not shoot on the course or practice butts unless accompanied by an adult member.
7. Always carry proof of membership (your membership card) when using the archery facilities.
8. Never shoot an arrow across the archery range or course at distant targets. Shoot only at the targets from the position set for them.
9. Never walk the range opposite the way it is laid out. Follow the paths that lead to the targets in progression.
10. Do not shoot at any wildlife that may be encountered while shooting the course.
11. Do not, in any way, mutilate the shrubbery, trees or archery equipment that make-up the range. It is there for your enjoyment.
12. Always check the target area and beyond before shooting.
13. Always stand your bow in front of the target when looking for arrows (especially behind the target area).
14. Do not shoot at a target that has a bow standing in front of the target face.
15. Be alert for archers who have failed to place their bows in front of the target face while looking for arrows.
16. Remove the target face while working around the target.
17. Never shoot at a target butt that has a target face missing.

18. Make sure your cigarettes, cigar, pipe ashes and matches are put out before discarding them.
19. Do not throw paper and trash on the archery facilities. Help keep the area clean.
20. The archery range shall be closed when there is a scheduled workday or when there is any special event being held (excluding bingo).
